## Adjunct Associate Professor Amanda Dines



Adjunct Associate Professor Amanda Dines is a Monash Medical graduate and has a Master's in Public Health in Health Care Management from the Harvard School of Public Health.

Amanda holds Fellowships of the Royal Australasian Colleges of Medical Administrators and General Practice and was a Senior Lecturer at the University of Queensland from 2010 to 2013 and became an Adjunct Associate Professor in 2018.

Amanda served in the Royal Australian Air Force as a Medical Officer for 24 years, during which time she was deployed on operational service to Iraq and East Timor, and commanded the RAAF Health Services Wing based at Amberley QLD, and the Canberra Area Medical Unit. From 2005-7, Amanda led the planning, coordination and professional oversight of health support to Australian military operations and exercises in Australia and overseas as the Chief Health Advisor to the ADF Joint Operations Commander.

Amanda joined the RBWH team in 2007 as the Deputy Executive Director Medical Service. She led the Centre for Medical Recruitment and Education (CMORE) and worked particularly with the Internal Medicine and Cancer Care Services and Pharmacy teams. She also played a role in establishing the training partnership with the Australian Defence Force and Australia's first hospital based Military Surgical Team. She transferred to the RAAF Specialist Reserve in 2007 and was an Honorary Aide de Camp to the Governor General from 2014.

She was the Executive Director Cancer Care RBWH and Metro North Hospital and Health Service (MNHHS) from 2013 to 2015. As the Executive Director of the Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital from 2015 to 2019 Amanda strengthened academic partnerships and played a key role in the establishment the Herston Imaging Research Facility and the Jamieson Trauma Institute. She went beyond the usual remit of the position and introduced specific initiatives which have improved care for patients in RBWH, MNHHS and Queensland.
